

COPPA Form for Verifiable Parental Consent

Dear Parents,

In order for Bridgewater Academy to continue to be able to provide your student with the most effective web-based tools and applications for learning, we need to abide by federal regulations that require a parent's signature as outlined below:

Bridgewater Academy utilizes several computer software applications and web-based services, operated not by Bridgewater Academy, but by third parties. These include Dropbox, Google Apps for Education, Sumdog and similar educational programs.

In order for our students to use these programs and services, certain personal identifying information, generally the student's name and email address must be provided to the website operator. Under federal law, these websites must provide parental notification and obtain parental consent before collecting personal information from children under the age of 13.

The law permits schools such as Bridgewater Academy to consent to the collection of personal information on behalf of all of its students, thereby eliminating the need for individual parent consent given to the web site operator.

This form will constitute consent for Bridgewater Academy to provide identifying information for your child consisting of first name, last name, email address and username to the following web-operators: Google Apps for Education, Dropbox, Evernote, Sumdog, Edmodo, Typing Programs and to the operators of any additional web-based educational programs and services which Bridgewater Academy may add during the upcoming academic year.

Please be advised that without receipt of this signed form, your child will not have access to the online resource available schoolwide and most of the Digital Arts Curriculum.
